Owners & Staff

Office & Store Hours:

High Season Hours are 9am – 8pm. Off Season Hours are posted at the Office.

Registration:

All campers must sign in and register at the office. Camping fees must be paid in advance. Do not change your assigned campsite without the approval of the office.

Visitors & Guests:

All Visitors must register with the office before entering the campground. There is fee for visitors and guests.. Visitors must leave the campground latest by 10.00 pm. Guests may stay overnight if they are registered and have paid the fee and if complying with the maximum occupancy per site/ Cabin.

Parking:

One RV and one vehicle per site. No parking other than on your site. To ensure a smooth check-in experience for fellow campers, do not block roads or access to sites, please. Additional parking as well as Visitor's parking is available in front of the office.

Children & Teenagers:

Parents are responsible for the behaviour, activities and safety of their children and teenagers at any time and any place. Children under 5 years of age must be accompanied by an adult in the restrooms and all other buildings and facilities. All children and teenagers must return to their campsite by 10.00pm.

Quiet Hours:

Are from 11:00pm – 8:00am. Loud or offensive noises and music will not be tolerated at any time and any place at the campground. Music off at 10pm and children back to their campsites by 10pm, please. Please respect your neighbours. Parties/ Grad parties are not permitted and will result in eviction from the Campground.

Courtesy:

Respect the rights and privacy of other campers. Don't walk or cut through other campsites, use roads or walkways, please.

Speed Limit: 15km/h

At all times and all places at the campground.

Washrooms:

We have two Washrooms buildings with showers. They are open 24/7 and will be frequently cleaned and sanitized. Keep restrooms and showers neat and clean. If there is a mess, please report it to the office. Don't enter with wet swim suits, please.

Laundry:

Open from 8:00am – 9:00pm

Games room:

Currently closed due to COVID-19

Playground:

Open daily from 9:00am – 9:00pm

Heated Swimming Pool:

Open from 9:00 am to 8:00pm (June 15 – Sept 15).

No lifeguard on duty. Registered guests only. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Pool rules are posted. No wet swimsuits in any building.

Campsite:

Keep your campsite clean. **Do not use firepit for littering.** Do not move the firepit. Do not dump black or gray water on the campsite, use only sewer hookup or dumpstation. No clothes lines on small trees. **No rugs on any grass area!! No generators at any time!**

Vehicles:

Maximum of 1 RV and 1 car allowed per site. Overflow parking is available in front of the Office. Electric cars need to be registered at the office. No major repairs or oil changes at any vehicles, RV's or generators. No vehicle, car or RV washing at any place at the campground.

Motorcycles:

Motorcycles, Minibikes and mopeds are prohibited to be used for pleasure at the campground. Only to use for transportation in and out of the campground.

Bicycles:

Only to be used on roads. Never on sidewalks, on the playground, in swimming pool area or on grassy areas.

Pets:

Must be kept on a leash always. Do not leave pets unattended. Please clean up after your pet. Keep them out of buildings, Pool and playground areas. Pets should not disturb other campers and pets. Excessive dog barking will not be tolerated.

Garbage:

Green Garbage bins have been placed throughout the campground (see map). Please bag and tie trash and place it inside the designated containers. Do not leave trash outside overnight.

Recycling:

Recycling containers have been placed throughout the campground to recycle Cans, Plastic bottles, and Glass bottles.

Trees:

Do not cut trees and branches or haul brush or wood of forested areas. Help us to protect. Protect trees that just have been planted on your site. Thank you.

Campfire & Firewood:

Campfires are allowed in general. If there are restrictions or a Burn ban, it will be posted. Use only designated firepits and douse your campfire when not attended. Firewood can be purchased during the store hours.

Camping Cabins:

No smoking or cooking, propane stoves or other types of open flames inside. Please keep your Cabin neat and clean. Pets are only allowed in the designated pet friendly Cabins. The other Cabins and Cottages are reserved for people with allergies.

Occupancy:

The maximum occupancy for each Campsite is one family unit or 4 adults. The maximum occupancy for Cabins is a family of four.

Rentals:

Canoe/ Kayak rentals are available for a fee. A liability waiver must be signed at the office. DVD rentals (complimentary) available at the office. Sport equipment can be rented at the office (baseball bats, basketball, soccer ball, frisbee etc.).

No responsibility for any accidents, injuries to persons and pets or damage to/ or theft of property or losses for any cause. We reserve the right to refuse service, limit the length of stay and the number of persons or vehicles per campsite, and/ or evict any person or party without refund.
